Pursuant to the Board's April 16, 2008 Order in the above-reference matter, enclosed are the original and ten copies of Public Service Electric and Gas Company's semi-annual report for the Solar Energy Program ("Solar Loan Program"). This program covers the period from April 2008 through December 31, 2012.

The PSE\&G Solar Loan Program was implemented for commercial customers on April 17, 2008 and for residential customers on July 16, 2008. As of June 30, 2012, PSE\&G had received a total of 325 loan applications for 46.77 MW of solar output. PSE\&G closed 169 solar loans representing 22.17 MW of constructed solar projects. The Solar Loan Program no longer has any loans pending.
