

New Jersey's Clean Energy Successor Solar Incentives (SuSI) Program

Administratively Determined Incentive (ADI) Program <u>Revised</u> SREC-II Incentive Levels Effective March 13, 2023

Per <u>Board Order</u> dated March 6, 2023, *IN THE MATTER OF A SUCCESSOR SOLAR INCENTIVE PROGRAM PURSUANT TO P.L. 2021, C. 169, ORDER REGARDING THE ONE YEAR REVIEW OF THE ADMINISTRATIVELY DETERMINED INCENTIVE*, the Board has established new incentive levels for eligible solar facilities seeking to participate in the ADI Program. The SREC-II incentive level adjustments in the table below will be implemented on **March 13, 2023**, the effective date of the Board Order.

Eligibility for Revised ADI Incentive (SREC-IIs) Values Per Market Segment

<u>Net-Metered Residential Market Segment</u>, the incentive level reduction will apply to solar facilities that have submitted a complete registration in the ADI Program <u>on or after</u> the effective date of the Board Order, March 13, 2023. Net-Metered Residential registration packets that are submitted prior to March 13, 2023, that are rejected due to a major deficiency or are deemed to have a minor deficiency that do not comply within the seven business days set out in the rules, will be required to resubmit a new ADI registration. The new ADI registration will have no reference to the previous registration and will be eligible for the lower incentive level.

<u>Non-Residential Market Segment</u>, the incentive level increase will apply to solar facilities that submit new registrations and for registrations that have previously been registered in the ADI Program but have not yet been issued permission to operate from the Electric Distribution Company (EDC), as of the effective date of the Board Order, March 13, 2023.
