Get started with an audit

An NJCEP pre-qualified auditing firm will conduct an assessment equivalent to an ASHRAE Level-2 Audit and follow the program's strict parameters to analyze your buildings and prepare the audit report. The program subsidizes 100% of the audit cost up to \$100,000 per fiscal year.

Take steps towards efficiency

With your Local Government Energy Audit report, you'll have a clear guide on how to upgrade your buildings as well as the NJCEP incentives available to offset implementation costs. The report provides a detailed list of recommended energy-efficiency measures and facility upgrades that will reduce your building's energy use and operating costs.

The Local Government Energy Audit is available to select customers for a variety of buildings:

- municipalities
- local governments
- state contracting agencies
- public agencies
- state colleges and universities
- 501(c)(3) non-profit agencies

New Jersey's Clean Energy Program Local Government Energy Audit Program Application Process

Submit your Request for Proposal (RFP) with LGEA registration and the Facility Data Form found at NJCleanEnergy.com/LGEA, and one of the following:

Governments:
the resolution passed by your local governing body authorizing you to apply to the program.

Non-profits:
a copy of your IRS tax-exemption letter verifying 501(c)(3) status.

Receive approval of RFP.

Send final RFP to all pre-qualified energy-auditing firms, select firm, and submit Firm Selection Form and other required documents for approval.

Receive approval of firm selection.

Execute contract with approved firm, perform audit and submit audit report for approval.

Receive approval of final energy audit report.

Submit Incentive Request Form, final energy audit report and energy audit invoice.
