2. Staff's white paper on transitioning the New Jersey Clean Energy Program to a new structure in 2011.



The comment period on transitioning the New Jersey Clean Energy Program to a new structure will close on Friday November 26, 2010. After reviewing public comments, the Board will decide on the 2011 New Jersey Clean Energy Program budget and the transition of the NJCEP which will occur in 2011.
