



WARMAdvantage Program Rebate Application Instructions, Terms and Conditions

For Systems Purchased on or after August 1, 2015 through July 31, 2016

A. CUSTOMERS - TO QUALIFY FOR YOUR REBATE, YOU MUST

- 1. Purchase, install and operate a high-efficiency equipment as outlined in the table below.
- 2. Replace and/or retrofit an installation in an existing New Jersey home which is supplied with natural gas, oil, propane, IOU (public) electric, or municipal or co-op electric.
- 3. The efficiency levels are based on the ratings found at AHRI directory (AHRIdirectory.org), ENERGY STAR® listing (energystar.gov) or CEE-AHRI directory.
- 4. Abide by the rules and rebate levels in effect at the date of purchase.
- 5. All units must be purchased by July 31, 2016; however all applications must be postmarked within 180 days of the purchase date to be eligible. Please see below "C. Important Terms and Conditions" items 1 and 2 for funding availability.

C. IMPORTANT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. This program is based on availability of funds. Procedures, requirements and rebate levels are subject to change and the program is subject to cancellation without notice.
- 2. Funding for this rebate program for oil, propane, municipal and co-op electric customers is provided through the United States Department of Energy State Energy Program (SEP) and is subject to closure at any time.
- 3. Due to the limited availability of funds, the program will terminate when funds are exhausted or July 31, 2016, whichever comes first. Notice will be posted on MJCleanEnergy.com
- 4. It is the responsibility of the customer to assure that all requirements for the rebate are met and that all required documentation is provided.
- 5. Failure to provide any of the required information will prevent processing of your application.
- 6. Rebate eligibility will be based on the equipment purchase date.
- 7. Incentives are available for the installation of qualified HVAC and/or water heater equipment in existing residential buildings; newly constructed homes are not eligible.
- 8. Please allow up to 120 days from the date New Jersey's Clean Energy Program (NJCEP) receives all required information to process your rebate.
- 9. NJCEP reserves the right to inspect all installations in order to ensure compliance with all program requirements.
- 10. NJCEP provides no oversight or control over any contractor services related to this program. Responsibility for proper sizing of equipment, as well as delivery and workmanship related to any equipment or services the customer procures, rests exclusively with the contractor selected by the customer. NJCEP assumes no responsibility for oversight of contractor services.
- 11. NJCEP audits its rebate programs as a protection against consumer and/or contractor fraud. Any attempt to defraud NJCEP will result in automatic rejection of the rebate application and possible legal action.
- 12. Contractors are required to comply with state and local plumbing, electrical and building codes and regulations and other requirements applicable under federal, state and local authority.
- 13. Customers participating in other programs within NJCEP or New Jersey Weatherization Assistance Programs may not be eligible for rebates.
