The New Jersey Board of Public Utilities has scheduled a hearing to receive comments on the New Jersey Clean Energy Program (NJCEP) Comprehensive Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy Resource Analysis (CRA) for Fiscal Year (FY) 2018 and related programs and budgets for FY2018. The public hearing on the FY18 CRA and the program budgets and filings will take place on **June 16, 2017 at the Department of Environmental Protection, 401 East State Street, Trenton, NJ - Public Hearing Room at 10:00 a.m.** A brief presentation will be held on the CRA and the budgets and filings.

The FY18 CRA is a one-year planning document that explores New Jersey's achievable potential for energy savings, the costs associated with those savings, and future technology resources. The proposed CRA funding level and FY18 budget will fully fund the NJCEP


