Pursuant to the Open Public Meetings Act, <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 10:4-6 <u>et seq.</u>, the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities ("Board") hereby gives notice of a Public Hearing on Thursday **November 10, 2011**, beginning at 1:00 p.m. in the Rutgers EcoComplex, 1200 Florence-Columbus Road, Bordentown, NJ 08505-4200 to discuss the Staff straw proposal for a 15-year solar alternative compliance payment ("SACP") schedule as input to the development of proposed regulatory amendments to satisfy the Solar Energy Advancement and Fair Competition Act of 2010. President Solomon will preside.

At the hearing, the Board will provide an opportunity for public comment on the following:

- 1. Staff's SACP 15-year schedule straw proposal for energy year 2012 through 2026.
- 2. ACP Advisory Committee comments on Staff's straw SACP schedule and alternate proposed SACP schedules.

The comment period for 15-year SACP schedule will end at 5:00 p.m. on Monday **November 14, 2011**. All comments will be posted to the NJCEP website at the end of the comment period.

After reviewing the public comments, Board Staff will present the matter for the Board's consideration at the next available Agenda meeting.
