

Successor Solar Incentive (SuSI) Program Administratively Determined Incentive (ADI) Program

Subject: Reallocation of ADI Program Capacity

Per the ADI Program rules **N.J.A.C. 14:8-11.7 (c)** ...the Board may adjust the market segments or create new market segments through a Board order to reflect changes in the solar market.

For Energy Year 2025, the ADI capacity allocated for the residential market segment was 200 Megawatts (MW). As of March 20, 2025, 172 MW have been subscribed, leaving 28 MW until May 31, 2025. At this pace, the residential market segment will be fully subscribed well before the conclusion of the Energy Year.

Per <u>Board Order</u>, dated 3/19/2025 (effective date 3/26/2025), *In the Matter of a Successor Solar Incentive Program Pursuant to P.L. 2021, C., 169; Order Reallocating Capacity in the ADI Program*, the Board has approved reallocating 75 MW of solar capacity to the ADI residential capacity block.
