I certify that my inability to submit an initial registration package within ten days of execution of my contract for the purchase or installation of the photovoltaic panels to be used in my solar facility was due to the interruption to normal mail delivery and/or to the operations of the New Jersey Clean Energy Program caused by Tropical Storm Sandy. I understand that the New Jersey Renewable Portfolio Standard regulations governing solar system eligibility for SRECs require registration within the SREC Registration program within ten days of execution of a contract N.J.A.C. 14:8-2.4(c)(1). Failure to register a solar electric facility within the mandated ten day period may result in the inability to retire SRECs from the system within its first year of operation.
