

New Jersey's Clean Energy ProgramTM WARMAdvantage and COOLAdvantage HVAC Programs for 2013

Dear Participating Contractor:

Thank you for your commitment to the New Jersey residential HVAC programs. We appreciate your participation and your efforts to reduce New Jersey's energy dependence. This notice includes important changes for 2013.

Purchases made prior to the date of the changes below will be processed according to current program guidelines and incentives.

Hurricane Sandy enhanced incentives may also be available in addition to the incentives on qualifying equipment below. Refer to <u>NJCleanEnergy.com/SANDY</u> for eligibility and instructions to qualify.

2013 KEY PROGRAM CHANGES:

COOLAdvantage Program:

- Incentives on Central A/C systems are discontinued for purchases on or after **February 24, 2013** except for customers whose homes have been damaged due to Hurricane Sandy who may still qualify for the \$500 incentive.
- For customers impacted by **Hurricane Sandy**, an enhanced **\$200** incentive per unit will be offered on qualifying heat pumps and ductless mini-split units in addition to the incentive payments shown on the following page. This enhanced incentive is retroactive for purchases made on or after **October 29**, **2012**.

WARMAdvantage Program:

- Furnaces that are 92% AFUE or greater and ENERGY STAR[®] statewide are eligible for a \$400 incentive for purchases on or after October 29, 2012 and a \$250 incentive for purchases on or after February 24, 2013.
- Gas Water Heaters .82 EF or greater, ENERGY STAR, and Gas Water Heaters with a minimum Thermal Efficiency (TE) of 90%, sealed combustion increase to **\$500**.
- Power Vent Water Heaters 0.67 EF or greater, ENERGY STAR are now eligible for a \$500 incentive.
- Combination installations of a qualifying AFUE 92% gas furnace with a qualifying water heater are eligible for **\$900** for purchases on or after **February 24, 2013.**
- For customers impacted by **Hurricane Sandy**, an enhanced **\$200** incentive <u>per unit</u> will be offered on qualifying furnaces, boilers, and water heaters in addition to the incentive payments shown on the following page. This enhanced incentive is retroactive for purchases made on or after **October 29, 2012**.

State Energy Program (SEP) HVAC Program:

• The SEP Program for municipal and co-op electric, propane, and oil customers will mirror the HVAC incentive schedule and will continue through June 30, 2013 or until funds are exhausted. **Hurricane Sandy** enhanced incentives apply to these customers as well.
